A permanent named endowed scholarship, named in honor or in memory of someone, is a “forever scholarship,” as Bethlehem University Foundation invests your gift in the United States and uses a set percentage of the interest earned to cover the expenses associated with educating one student at Bethlehem University.

You can fully fund a permanent and perpetually named endowed scholarship for \$100,000. A minimum gift of \$30,000 can establish a base for an endowed scholarship (which may be the sum of gifts over a period of time such as 3 to 5 years – and can also be the result of a number of people pooling their donations together).
